

Neato Botvac D8000 Battery Replacement

INTRODUCTION

Follow these steps to remove or replace a dead battery from your Neato Botvac D8000.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- Flathead Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery





Turn the robot upside down to locate the battery cover.

Step 2









- Use a Phillips #1 screwdriver to unscrew both of the 20mm screws.
- Gently lift the battery cover.
- Remove the battery cover to reveal the battery.

Step 3







- Use a flathead screwdriver to push down on the latch of the battery clip.
- Simultaneously, pull on the battery while pushing down on the latch to detach the battery from the clip.

♠ Do not pull on the wires that are connected to the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
