


## **Faulty Plug Prongs Repair**

If the device doesn't power up because the prongs on your power cord are loose or bent, this guide will tell you how to make it work again.

## Step 1 — Faulty Plug Prongs Repair



- Find the power cord.
- Make sure that it is unplugged from the outlet. This is to make sure that no power is flowing through and you are not injured.

## Step 2



- If the prongs are bent out of shape, take the pliers and slowly apply pressure so that the prongs bend back to their regular shape.
- it doesn't have to be perfect. It just has to fit into the outlet.

## Step 3



 Plug the power cord into the outlet and make sure that it's connected to the device.
