## INTRODUCTION


If you own the Samsung Galaxy On5 replacing the battery is a breeze. If your phone isn't turning on or the screen is frozen, use these steps to remove the battery.



## Step 1 — Battery




- Locate the side notch that allows you to open the back casing.

## Step 2



- Use a plastic prying tool or your fingernail to pop the back cover off of the phone.

## Step 3



- Locate the battery notch and remove the battery, using either your finger or a plastic prying tool.
- ⚠ Be careful not to puncture the battery. Lithium-ion batteries are highly flammable when exposed to oxygen.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
