


# Acer Aspire S3-391-6046 Keyboard Replacement

• Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Back Cover



Place laptop upside down.

## Step 2






Remove the twelve 5mm screws with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.



• Lift cover upwards away from you.


#### Step 4 — Keyboard







- Remove the four Phillips #0 screws that are connected to the left and right speakers.
- Carefully disconnect the wires that connect the speaker to the rest of the computer.




 Remove two Phillips #0 screws that are beside the ends of the gray wire.


## Step 6








- Remove the gray wire slowly with tweezers.
- Carefully peel wire off.




 Slowly remove the two wires that are to the left of the battery with tweezers in an upward pulling motion.

## Step 8




Completely remove the battery out of its position.





- Remove the five Phillips #0 screws that are on the border of the laptop.
- Disconnect the white wire that is below the fan.





- Flip all of the circuits upwards.
- Remove all Phillips #0 screws.
- Remove the keyboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
