INTRODUCTION

This guide will demonstrate how to change the RAM (random access memory) in a Toshiba Qosmio X775-3DV80. RAM is used as storage for temporary data. Browsers, media players, and applications are just some of the programs that utilize the quick access RAM to function.

Computers with more RAM can run a greater amount of programs simultaneously. As such, installing larger RAM sticks is one of the best and simplest methods for upgrading your laptop. Whether you're upgrading or replacing faulty sticks, this guide can help.

Before starting, please make sure to turn off and unplug the computer. The RAM may be hot if the computer has been running recently.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tool (1)
- Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Battery





Turn your laptop over so the underside is facing up.

Step 2





- Identify the two sliding locks on either side of the battery.
- Simultaneously slide both locks outward to release the battery.

Step 3



 Pull the battery straight out of its slot to remove it.

Step 4 — RAM



- Loosen the single screw on the service panel by twisting counterclockwise with a Phillips #00 screwdriver.
- it is a captive screw that will remain attached to the service panel.

Step 5



 Using a spudger or plastic opening tool, pry off the service panel.

Step 6







- Using your fingers, pull the retaining clips away from the RAM sticks.
- Pull the RAM sticks out of the slots.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
