



How to Remove Stickers From a Car

INTRODUCTION

Sometimes we may find the stickers on our cars unwanted. In this case, we would like to remove the stickers without damaging our beautiful car paint. In this guide, I will show you how to remove stickers from a car properly.

TOOLS:

Hair Dryer (1)

Plastic Cards (1)

Razor Blade (1)

Microfiber Cleaning Cloths (1)

Cleaning Spray (1)

Step 1 — How to Remove Stickers From a Car



- First of all, find the area where the sticker is. In my case, it is on the car body near the fuel tank.

Step 2



- Spray the area with some soap water or with cleaning sprays.

Step 3



- Next, wipe the area thoroughly with a [microfiber](#) cleaning cloth.

Step 4



- Turn on the hairdryer and put it in its hot setting.
 - Start heating the sticker from a few inches away. Try to heat the sticker from the center outward.
- ⓘ This will soften the adhesive under the sticker and make the following steps much easier.

Step 5



- Use a [plastic card](#) and try to scrape the sticker from the edges.
- ① A plastic card can help you remove your unwanted stickers without damaging the paint.
- If it doesn't work, try to repeat step 4 and then try again.
- ① If you are working on a glass surface, use a razor blade instead of a plastic card! It may seem too much for the glass, but the glass is hard enough to use a razor blade on.

⚠ Be careful when using a razor blade!

Step 6



- Finally, if there is any residue, heat the residue with the hairdryer and scrape it off with a plastic card or razor blade (depending on where the sticker is).
- After removing all stickers and residue, use some detailing spray or cleaning spray to clean the area again and you are all set!

After these steps, you should have a clean surface without any residues!
