Use this guide to replace or remove the SIM card tray on your Google Pixel 5a.



• iFixit Precision 4 mm Screwdriver Bit (1)

SIM Eject

Step 1 — Eject the SIM card tray







- Insert a SIM card eject tool into the small hole on the right side edge of the frame.
 - (i) A standard <u>SIM card eject tool</u> may be too wide for the job. Don't force the tool in—use a small paperclip, or a properly sized tool, like the <u>SIM eject bit</u>.
- Press firmly until you feel the SIM card tray pop out.
- Remove the SIM card tray from the phone.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

Take your e-waste to an R2 or e-Stewards certified recycler.
