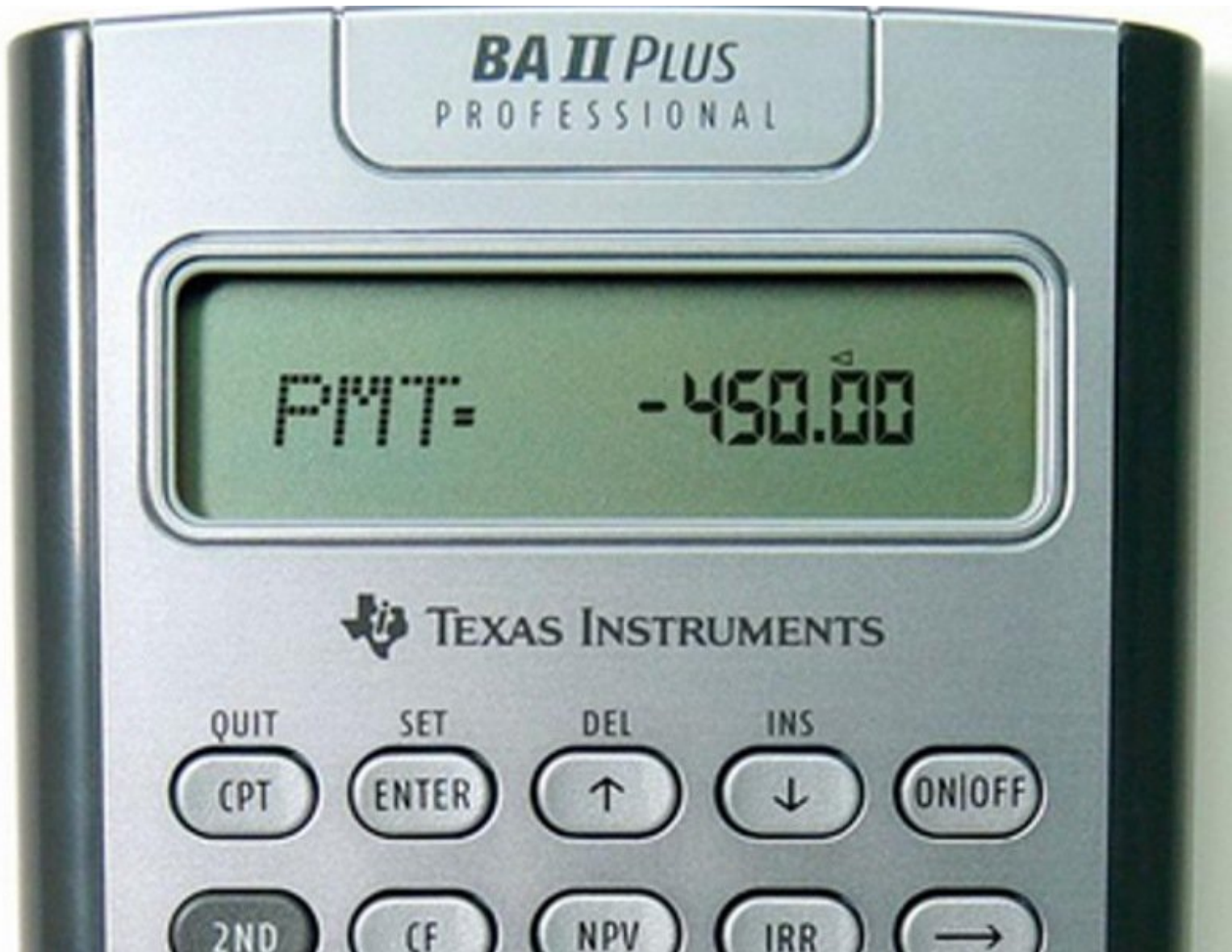




Texas Instruments TI BA II Plus Teardown

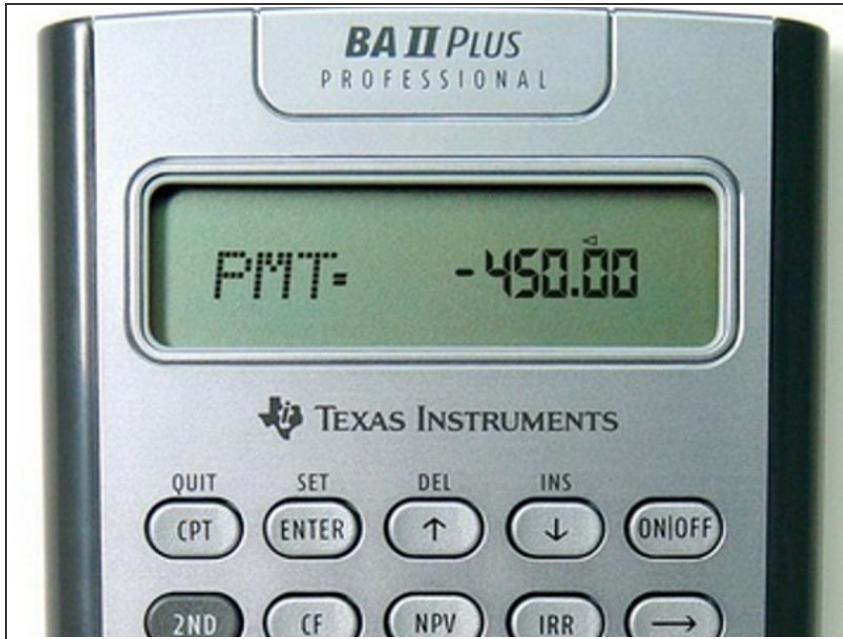
Teardown of the TI BA II Plus calculator.

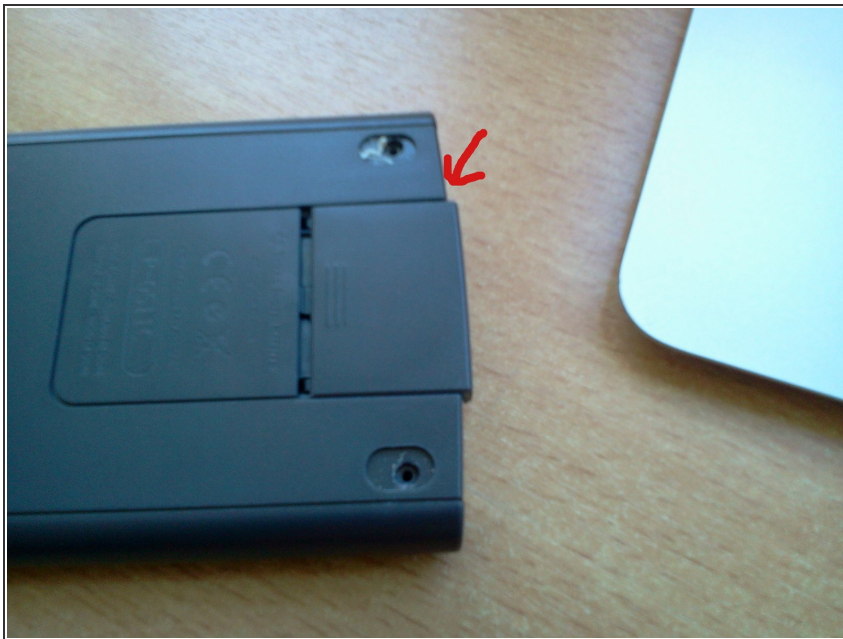
- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Texas Instruments TI BA II Plus Teardown



- The BA II Plus Professional calculator.

Step 2



- Remove the battery cover by sliding it out.

Step 3



- Firstly on the back cover, remove the small sticky soft cushioning material covering the recess with the screws in it. 4 of them in total. Unscrew them.

Step 4



- Use a flathead screwdriver to gently part the bottom and top cover at the hinge on the top.

Step 5



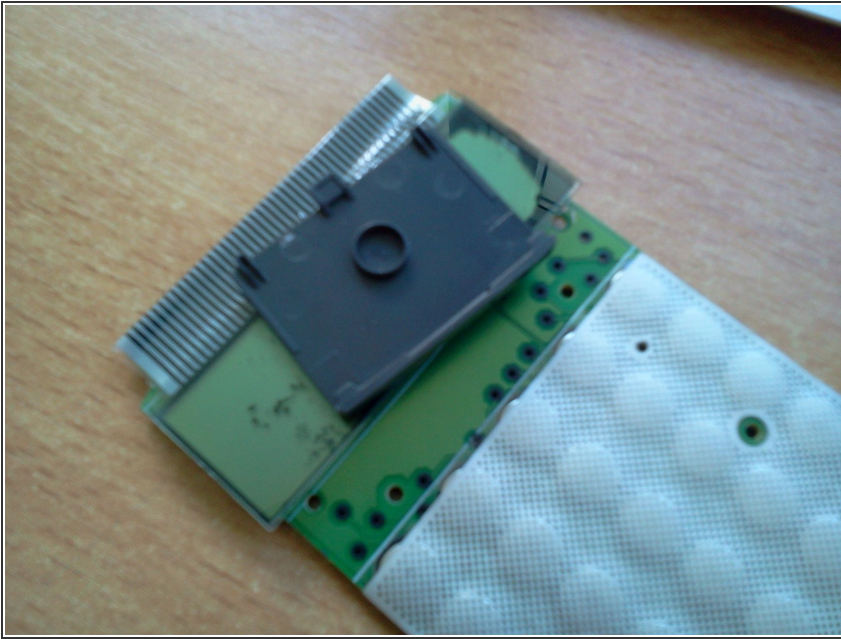
- Removing the back cover to reveal the foil, unscrew the 4 screws holding the foil and 4 other holding the printed circuit board to the front cover.

Step 6



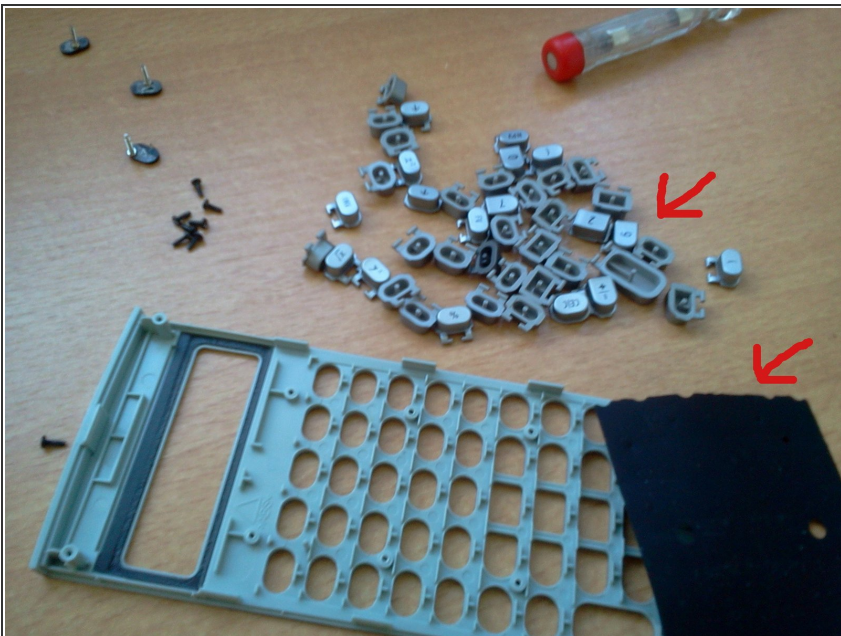
- Remove the foil. Ensure all screws are off.

Step 7



- This must separate the front cover from the board. Remove the board and turn it over to view the front side with a soft black cushion cover over a smooth shinny mesh.

Step 8



- The keys should fall out of the front cover when you turn it over as well. Thats it!!!

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
