

Infant Optics DXR-5 Camera Lens Replacement

The purpose of this guide is to show the steps required to replace the camera lens of the camera unit for the Infant Optics DXR-5.

INTRODUCTION

Ensure that the camera unit is unplugged prior to starting this guide.

Secure screws to avoid losing them.

Screws are small and can pose a possible choking hazard for small children.



TOOLS:

Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)


Step 1 — Camera






 Using a Phillips #2 screwdriver, remove the four, 6.0 mm Phillips screws from the back of the camera unit.

Step 2





- Pull up on the two beige tabs to the left and right of the ribbon connected to the camera.
- Pull the ribbon straight out from the camera.


Step 3





Remove the front face plate of the camera unit by carefully pulling it off.

Step 4 — Camera Lens





- Using a Phillips #2 screwdriver, remove the two 6.0 mm Phillips screws that hold the camera lens on.
- These two screws have a different thread than the four screws that secure the camera unit's housing.
