INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to help you replace a scratched, scuffed, bent or broken bottom panel on your MacBook Pro 15" Retina Display Mid 2015.



TOOLS:

 P5 Pentalobe Screwdriver Retina MacBook Pro and Air (1)



PARTS:

- MacBook Pro 15" Retina (Late 2013-Mid 2015) Lower Case (1)
- MacBook Pro Retina (2012 to 2015)
 Lower Case Screw Set (1)

Step 1 — Lower Case




- Remove the following P5 pentalobe screws securing the lower case to the MacBook Pro:
 - Eight 3.1 mm
 - Two 2.3 mm

Step 2



Lifting from the edge nearest the clutch cover, lift the lower case off the MacBook Pro.

Step 3







- (i) The lower case has two plastic pegs (red) that fit into plastic clips in the upper case (orange).
- During reassembly, gently push down the center of the lower case to reattach the case to its two plastic clips.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
